

DATA PROTECTION POLICY



The Malta Institute of Professional Photography (MIPP) hereby gives notice that the main use of the personal information that its Members supply the MIPP with, is to enroll the data subject in the MIPP.

Personal data and any other information supplied to the MIPP will be recorded and processed as may be necessary by the MIPP for the purpose of achieving the local and international aims, objectives and ideals of the MIPP, and for any other purpose that may be necessary for the performance and attainment of MIPP ideals, or as may be allowed or required by law.

Please note that the MIPP will also process data for direct marketing purposes, such as to inform its Members, by mail, telephone, fax, e-mail or other electronic means, about activities and services supplied by the MIPP, its committee's /subcommittees members, associates, agents, and employees.

The MIPP undertakes not to transfer or exchange any information that it holds about its Members unnecessarily to or with any third parties without first obtaining its members written consent.

Please note that personal data may be disclosed to or exchanged with all the committee's/ subcommittees' Members when necessary.

The MIPP hereby informs the data subject/parent/legal guardian of the right to request information about the personal data held, and to rectify or to erase personal data in this respect, upon notification in writing and subject to the MIPP's obligations under Maltese Law.

Whilst the MIPP may periodically request its Members to re-confirm the above information, Members should inform the MIPP immediately if any of such information has changed.
